

Mikhail G. Revnivtsev Prize

"Prize in memory of Mikhail G. Revnivtsev"

The prize was established in memory of renowned high-energy astrophysicist Mikhail Revnivtsev and will be awarded to a young (below 35 years of age, as of October 31, 2018) scientist with excellent recent achievements in the field of X-ray and gamma-ray astronomy. The competition is open to individuals from all countries. Relevance will be attributed to scientific results obtained in the last 5 years (2014-2018) that have received significant recognition worldwide. The prize will be awarded at the 12th INTEGRAL Conference "INTEGRAL looks AHEAD to Multi-Messenger Astrophysics" in Geneva at February 11-15, 2018. It bears a monetary award, which will cover all expenses of the winner connected with the participation in the conference.

The deadline for nominations is December 31, 2018. Nominators should send a 1-page summary of the nominee CV and recent research and the corresponding list of publications in 2014-2018.

The prize was established by ESA/INTEGRAL, IKI and INAF. The first prize winner is Volodymyr Savchenko (2017).
